




Review of Safety Efforts to Date

- School trainings on drills and readiness for emergencies
- ALICE Refreshers and needed sites retraining in late September
- Drills for Schools (Fire, lock down, etc.)
- District Safety Committee Meeting in August (who, what, and how)
- Random checks of buildings in an ongoing basis
- Listing to school based employees of Crisis Manual specific plans
- Radios district wide
- Safety Meeting with School Based Teams around large events
- SRO trainings
- Handle with Care Program partnership and proactive supports of students




I have at least one adult in my school that I can go to with helping me solve problems.




I feel safe before and after school while on school grounds.


I feel safe at school.




Teachers and administrators supervise the hallways during class change.






I feel that I belong to my school.








Name calling, insults, or teasing happen regularly at my school.

I have some understanding of the program and its practices.






Students respect adults in our school/department.



The school buildings seems to be secure during the day.








Teachers and staff members make sure that school rules are followed.

Next Steps & Feedback

- ADDRESS individual school safety plans providing us with a comprehensive, locally designed plan with school input at the forefront to further address safety concerns.
- **INCORPORATE** survey results to ask District Safety committee to make recommendations to cabinet based on school feedback.
- **ESTABLISH** an ongoing loop of safety specific reporting and feedback.
- **SHARE** with stakeholders the general outcomes of the surveys and actionable efforts from schools and district teams.
- **PURCHASE** weapons screening devices to be used randomly around district for preventative support.
